

Scholarship for the Physically Challenged Requirements

Available to students attending high school in the state of Texas, Believe It Foundation provides <u>one</u> eligible high school senior or college undergrad a \$2500 scholarship to attend the accredited college or university of their choice.

To qualify for the Believe It Foundation Scholarship, applicants:

- 1. Must have a significant physical challenge and may or may not use a wheelchair for mobility. The physical challenge must affect activities of daily living.
- 2. Must have at least a 3.0 GPA either as a graduating high school senior or in their college coursework.
- 3. Must show financial need
- 4. Must be applying to, or currently attending, an accredited four or two year college within the United States.
- 5. Must be a legal resident of the United Stated.
- 6. Must submit an application with all required attachments by April 1.

Recipients of the scholarship may be awarded the scholarship for up to a maximum of 4 years. To be considered for the subsequent year, recipients:

- 1. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA in their college coursework during the year for which the previous scholarship was awarded.
- 2. Must submit a new application for each year, with the most current information and transcripts.
- 3. Must submit a written essay with the application describing how something in the previous college year has affected your life.
